

TOWN OF NEW HOLSTEIN

ORDINANCE No. 2024-3

The Town Board of the Town of New Holstein, Calumet County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30 (1e)(a), the offices of the Town Clerks and Town Treasurer, exceed 3 (three) years per § 60.30 (1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer(s) for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 and required by § 60.30 (1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the Town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The referendum question(s) shall be:

"Shall the person holding office of Town Clerk in the Town of New Holstein be appointed by the Town Board?"

"Shall the person holding office of Town Treasurer in the Town of New Holstein be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by § 60.30 (1e)(b).
